





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

Practical Questions

- 7. Triphati and Chauhan are partners in a firm sharing profits and losses in the ratio of 3:2. Their capitals were Rs.60,000 and Rs.40,000 as on January 01, 2005. During the year they earned a profit of Rs. 30,000. According to the partnership deed both the partners are entitled to Rs. 1,000 per month as Salary and 5% interest on their capital. They are also to be charged an interest of 5% on their drawings, irrespective of the period, which is Rs. 12,000 for Tripathi, Rs. 8,000 for Chauhan. Prepare Partner's Accounts when, capitals are fixed.
- 8. Anubha and Kajal are partners of a firm sharing profits and losses in the ratio of 2:1. Their capital, were Rs.90,000 and Rs.60,000. The profit during the year were Rs. 45,000. According to partnership deed, both partners are allowed salary, Rs. 700 per month to Anubha and Rs. 500 per month to Kajal. Interest allowed on capital @ 5% p.a. The drawings at the end of the period were Rs. 8,500 for Anubha and Rs. 6,500 for Kajal. Interest is to be charged @ 5% p.a. on drawings. Prepare partners capital accounts, assuming that the capital account are fluctuating.
- 9. Harshad and Dhiman are in partnership since April 01, 2006. No Partnership agreement was made. They contributed Rs. 4,00,000 and 1,00,000 respectively as capital. In addition, Harshad advanced an amount of Rs. 1,00,000 to the firm, on October 01, 2006. Due to long illness, Harshad could not participate in business activities from August 1, to September 30, 2006. The Profits for the year ended March 31, 2006 amounted to Rs. 1,80,000. Dispute has arisen between Harshad and Dhiman. Harshad Claims: (i) he should be given interest @ 10% per annum on capital and loan; (ii) Profit should be distributed in proportion of capital; Dhiman Claims: (i) Profits should be distributed equally; (ii) He should be allowed Rs. 2,000 p.m. as. Remuneration for the period he managed the business, in the absence of Harshad; (iii) Interest on Capital and loan should be allowed @ 6% p.a. You are required to settle the dispute between Harshad and Dhiman. Also prepare Profit and Loss Appropriation Account.
- 10. Aakriti and Bindu entered into partnership for making garment on April 01, 2006 without any Partnership agreement. They introduced Capitals of Rs. 5,00,000 and Rs. 3,00,000 respectively on October 01, 2006. Aakriti Advanced. Rs, 20,000 by way of loan to the firm without any agreement as to interest. Profit and Loss account for the year ended March 2007 showed profit of Rs, 43,000. Partners could not agree upon the question of interest and the basis of division of profit. You are required to divide the profits between them giving reason for your solution.
- 11. Rakhi and Shikha are partners in a firm, with capitals of Rs. 2,00,000 and Rs, 3,00,000 respectively. The profit of the firm, for the year ended 2006-07 is Rs. 24,200. As per the Partnership agreement, they

share the profit in their capital ratio, after allowing a salary of Rs. 5,000 per month to Shikha and interest on Partner's capital at the rate of 10% p.a. During the year Rakhi withdrew Rs. 7,000 and ShikhaRs. 10,000 for their personal use. You are required to prepare Profit and Loss Appropriation Account and Partner's Capital Accounts.
